Making the unsafe assumption that she was the daughter of a married couple, there are only two possibilities (George Currell and Elizabeth had a daughter Elizabeth who was living with them in 1851): James and Elizabeth Currell and Shadrack and Mary Currell. Although Elizabeth was living near Shadrack's son, Robert in 1851 and might therefore be his sister, I feel that she was more likely the daughter of James and Elizabeth. They have no recorded daughter named after Elizabeth - and a son is named after his father, James. Also, Elizabeth named a daughter, Martha. The only other Martha Currell at Norton was the daughter of Elizabeth's possible brother, George. This theory is weak and identification is not helped by the witnesses at Elizabeth's wedding who were William and Rebecca Scales who were her husband's sister and husband. | |
