

NOTES RE: INDIVIDUALS ON WRAY TREE

1 WRAY	Robert	Banns: Robert and Jane both of this parish. Both marked at marriage. Witnesses: Elizabeth Wray (sis?) and Henry Cutts. Robert a witness at Elizabeth's marriage. 1814 PR Hurdlemaker C41 Hurdle maker of Upper Green, Tewin ML Hurdle maker 1801 C51 as C41 with nephew James Hastings 18 hurdle maker. C61 Widower with dau Elizabeth Wray, and visitor Jane Anne Crawley b1852 Hertingfordbury. C71 at Molewood Road, Bengoe with dau Elizabeth, married son Benjamin (hurdle maker and grandson John b 1853 Hertford hurdle maker At Hertingfordbury when he died aged 88.
4 WRAY	Esther	C51 at Newlands House, Stanstead, Herts - a servant for a proprietor of houses. C1901 at 3 Wellington Road, Watford - lets appartments (lodging house?)
6 WRAY	Rebecca	C51 a cook at Woodside Place, Hatfield. C1901 with sis Elizabeth at Hertingfordbury.
7 WRAY	William	C51/61 at Waterford, Bengoe a hurdlemaker C71 living next door to father Robert at Molewood Road, Bengoe. No children C81 at 3 Molewood Road a sawyer, D House Proprietor. DK death
8 WRAY	Elizabeth	C51 Svt at St Peters St., Hertford Unmarried with father C61/71 C81 At New Road, Cowbridge, Hertford a housekeeper C1901 at Hertingfordbury living with sis Rebecca Crawley both living on own means. Aged 98 at death!
9 WRAY	William	No sign of Wm in C41 ML 1778-1783 Hurdlemaker (2 ch 1781) Correct marriage (despite being at Hertingfordbury) because in banns Wm of parish of Tewin and Mary of Hertingfordbury. When Sal baptized at Tewin 1800, Wm and Mary of the parish of Hatfield
12 WRAY	William	C51/61 at Bull Stag Green, Hatfield hurdlemaker with Margaret Dunkley widow sister in law and her son John (b 1838 Holborn, M-sex)
13 WRAY	Anne	PR of Hatfield when died
15 WRAY	Elizabeth	Death Index - wdw of James
16 WALDOCK	Ann	Of Weston in banns
18 WRAY	Benjamin	C41 Hurdlemaker C51/61 St Andrew St., Hertford - Hurdlemaker C71 with father, hurdlemaker C81 with sis Elizabeth and son John (both hurdle makers) C91 with son Robert at 1 Fanshaw St., Bengoe C1901 living with son William a hurdlemaker at Church Road, Hertford
19 WRAY	Hannah	C41 Hannah was possibly the publican at Plume and Feathers, Upper Green, Tewin. The entry has been over-written and now reads Wigs but it may well have been Wray originally. Possibly married 1843 in Hatfield Reg District. DK spouse.
20 WRAY	Joseph	Death Herts B Index aged 22
21 HARDING	Emma	Emma was born Emma Hays. She m James Harding at St Albans 4 5 1828 and had Berthia x 7 11 1830 Tewin and James x15 12 1833 Tewin who were living with her and Benjamin Wray C41
25 WRAY	Henry	Possibly in Tewin ML 1762 Lbr. Thus, moved from Hatfield to Tewin C1760. Hatfield is adjacent parish to Tewin 4 miles. (Evidence that this is the correct family - 1. Ann Ray's Burial at Tewin 2. James Ray hurdlemaker at Tewin, 1781-1792 3. Anne Wray m John Cutt 1772 at Tewin and had children there. She died in 1821 aged 69)
26 MEAD	Ann	Widow at death
28 WRAY	Elizabeth	Possibly m Thomas Robinson Hatfield 10 5 1770 had 4 ch at Hatfield.
30 WRAY	James	James is probably in Tewin ML as hurdle maker 1781-92. No children in IGI
41 WILSON	James	Both marked at marriage. Witnesses Robert Wray and Ann Back???
42 CRAWLEY	George	C61/71 at Hertingfordbury next to post office a shoemaker C81 as above employing 2 men. C91 at Hertingfordbury a bootmaker
44 WRAY	Albert	C1901 Hurdlemaker
48 WRAY	Robert	C91 at 1 Fanshaw Road, Bengoe a hurdlemaker.
55 CRAWLEY	Jane	With Robert Wray C1861 visitor
56 SLADE	Ambrose	C61-1901 Ag Lab at North Curry, Somerset C1901 a mole catcher.
61 SLADE	Mark Wray	C1901 at Stoke Road, Stoke St Gregory near Taunton Withey tier
62 TURNER	Amos	C61 Journeyman carpenter at Wellham Greary, North Mimms, Herts. C71/81 at Green Street, Hatfield a carpenter C91 at Woodside, Green St, Hatfield - a gamekeeper
76 WRAY	Arthur	C71 a ploughboy C81 Ag lab C91 straw plaiter with mother C1901 at 47 North Street, Luton a labourer in works.
78 WRAY	Robert H	Hurdlemaker from Ley Green, signed at wedding 1899 at Wandon Green, Kings Walden C1901 domestic gardener at Kings Walden

93 WRAY	William	Marriage in BVRI confirms Wm's father was Henry. C41 at Burnham Green, Datchworth a hurdle maker C51 hurdlemaker with Mary Ann Keswell b1842 a visitor C61 at Groves Green, Datchworth - a hurdlemaker Death 1861-65 (there was a William Shadbolt who died June Qtr 1864 at Hertford Reg D.)
95 WRAY	Henry Wm	C61 possibly lodgin at Moor Fields House, Goole, Yorks. a farm servant. C71 a hurdlemaker at Datchworth, living next door to remarried mother, Sarah C81/91 hurdlemaker at Govers Green, Datchworth. With him are nephews Arthur and Harry Medhurst b Islington, London 1881, 1883. C1901 widower and hurdlemaker as above
96 WRAY	Alfred	C71 Private in 2nd battalion 17th regiment based at Aldershot. C81 Gunner in Royal Artillery at Govt Buildings, Hythe, Sandgate, Kent. C91 at Buck Lane, Watton a sawyer C1901 at Southgate Road, Potters Bar a Bricklayers Labr. Said b Woolmers Green.
97 WRAY	James	C71 living with Eliza Wiggs and family next door to Joseph Wray b Tewin 1824 C81/91/1901 at Upper Green, Tewin Ag Lab
113 WRAY	Frederick	General Labr C1901 died WW 1
133 WRAY	William	C91, a lab C1901 living with parents in law at 23 Bailey St., Luton next to or above Javelin Inn. A Flour Mill Engine Driver. Of 65 Park Road West, Luton in 1932
140 SMART	John	C1881 with parents at Ley Green, a general carrier. C1891, a coal dealer and carrier. C1901 a carrier at New Cottages, Ley Green
175 MILLER	James	C91 at Angel Row, Fivehead, Bridgewater, S-set. Ag Lab C1901 at Swell, S-set Ag lab
