

## NOTES RE: CURRELL OF ASTON, HERTS

- 3 Currell John Mary died a widow. No record of John's death in Aston PR No sign of John in Militia Lists - Aston, Stevenage or Willian. Did he die at Stevenage around 1755 and did Mary move back to Willian?
- 5 Currell Thomas Note: Allen Index states married as Ansell (check mother's maiden name) but the male surname variant is an alias. (Note Thos' age - he was only included in the Militia Lists from 1768-85 indicating that he was born circa 1750 A further indication that they were very young is that their last child was born in 1802!) Removal order 9 11 1801. 40 years ago went as a yearly servant to William Malky wheeler and farmer of Aston for 50/- per year serving 2 years. now married to Martha and has 12 children all aged over 12 years. Removed from Cheshunt to Aston. So children v difficult to trace.
- 8 Ellis Martha From Knebworth - Allen Index. Aged 98 at death
- 18 Currell John Militia List - John Farm Svt at Bayford 1796
- 19 Currell Benjamin Died aged 74 by visitation of God - Labourer. C41 Ag Lab at Aston End. C51 Shepherd at Burleigh Farm, widower Aged 82 at death. Bayford is 9 miles from Aston. Militia List, James Svt at Bayford 1792. Labourer at Norton End
- 20 Currell James 1816
- 28 Currell John C41 Living with James and Ann Mumford, farmer at Perry Wood, Watton, Ag Lab. C51 Ag Lab at Watton Street C61 Farm Lab at cottage between shop and police station at Watton
- 45 Bennett William C51 at Butcherley Green, Hertford Woodman, wife "Fanny" lodging with Joseph and Ann Stanbridge.
